

# Map of Prospect village and environs 1931

This map was produced by Douglas Grant (Terracon Geoscience Int'l) based on vertical airphoto NAPL A3891-61 (scale 1:15000 or 1 cm = 150 m) (kindly provided by Ed Rogers). It is the first airphoto of Prospect and one of the earliest in Canada. However, the original negative does not exist; a copy negative was used to make the airphoto print; it is not of optimum quality. Buildings are not wholly visible, except by their shadows, so adjustments have been made using later airphotos. Official placenames are added.
